## What is Project Adventure

The purpose of Adventure: Fayette County is to expose youth to afterschool and summer activities available in their area, while collecting data to help increase access to meaningful activities for all Fayette County youth.

The goal is to give all of our youth an opportunity to explore, learn and recreate in activities where they find connection, meaning and excitement.

On April 28 (4th graders) & 29 (5th graders) we hope you and your students will enjoy the day at Fayette County Park exploring some of these activities.

## STATIONS

Rotations are 45 minutes each. Some stations will take longer than others for students to travel between. Each rotation will have 60 - 80 students, 3 to 4 classes. The attached schedules show what other teacher's class(es) will be in your group. . Students will be able to "mingle" amongst presenters at each station, as every student will not be able to participate in an activity at the same time.

## Lunch

Lunch will be at your Rotation 5 station where a shelter has been designated for lunch. It is our understanding that schools will provide a bagged lunch for each student. If a student brings a lunch from home we ask that all packaging be disposable, no lunch boxes, etc. that needs to return home.

## Weather, Activities and Clothing

At this time, the forecast is for chilly temperatures especially in the mornings! Students will be outdoors all day and should dress in layers. There are activities on the water, and while we strongly encourage students to not be in the water, they are kids. It might be a good

Trained volunteers as well as experienced raft, SUP, and kayak presenters will fit all students with life jackets for pond activities! Safety is our first priority!

General volunteers and the Project Adventure Committee will be present throughout to assist you, and answer any questions. **You will receive a schedule and map when you arrive at the park!** We want teachers to have an enjoyable day with their students & hope all students attend!
