Adventure Guide:

Adventure Guides will be assigned to each class. You will board the bus with the students when they arrive. Greet the teachers and students and express enthusiasm for the fun they are about to have. You are their first contact and can help set the tone for the day. Emphasize safety first! Throughout the day you will help the class move on time from station to station. Engage with the kids, answer questions and help teachers if needed. HAVE FUN and help make sure the kids do too!

Station Assistants:

Station Assistants will stay with presenters at each location and help as needed. You may be helping students with life jackets etc. , making sure every student gets a turn for activities , and helping presenters as needed. You will also be watching the time and

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listening for the notice to change to help insure timely movement of groups to each station.

General Assistants:

May have specialized duties related to lunch, volunteer sign-in, etc. We will discuss details with you before the event.

STATIONS

Rotations are 45 minutes each. Some stations will take longer than others for students to travel between. Each rotation will have 60 - 80 students, grouped by classrooms of about 30 students. Students will be able to “mingle” amongst presenters at each station, follow the teacher’s lead for how the class moves and mingles.
